

Colorado National Golf Club Golf Course Safety

The Vista Ridge Homeowners Association and Colorado National Golf Club want to continue to remind residents and their guests that the golf course is private property for golfing customers only. “No Trespassing” signs are posted throughout the golf course. Golf course management may press charges for anyone else caught on the course, including cart paths, fairways, course rough and greens, creeks, and ponds.

It is very unsafe for the non-golfing public to be on the golf course, due to possible-errant golf shots, moving golf carts, and limited visibility hundreds of yards away. The Town of Erie has a number of trails and paths open to the public that are safer and better suited for year-round outdoor activities.

Also, frequently remind your children not to play, ride bikes, or cross through the golf course. Young mothers with baby strollers have even been seen walking down the fairways. We just don’t want to see anyone hurt!

Please remember that it is a privilege to live near such a beautiful golf course. We should be good neighbors and respect each other’s property.
